Section 17.52.010 Intent.

The intent in establishing historic districts is to safeguard and promote the history and heritage of Salisbury by preserving areas, structures and sites of cultural, social, economic, political, architectural and historical significance; to strengthen and improve the local economy by stabilizing and improving property values in these areas; to foster civic beauty; and to promote the use and preservation of these areas for the education, welfare and pleasure of the public. These areas contain numerous structures and sites representing a variety of historic and architectural periods which, once lost, cannot be replaced.
